The BabyPlus Prenatal Education System features a curriculum made up of 16 lessons that can be started anytime between 18 weeks (when Baby's hearing is fully developed) and 32 weeks of pregnancy. Strapped to your belly twice a day—one hour in the morning and one hour at night—the system introduces patterns of sounds in your baby's language, the maternal heartbeat, and encourages your baby to begin differentiating sound while still in the womb.

And while our pregnant mom testers weren't able to tell us whether the system help produce smarter babies (we're still waiting on **newborn IQ tests**, they thought it was user-friendly, comfortable, and a unique product.
